- Create a variety of cash flow statements
- Learn advanced formatting concepts
- Use Row Linking to speed up processing time and reduce maintenance requirements
- Create advanced income statement reports using multiple segments in the row format
- Create complex calculations such as specific column placement and conditional statements
- Learn to rotate (expenses in columns)
- Relational Reporting (percentage of sales)
